

## REMEMBERING Robert Michael Cashato ("Bob")

June 4, 1948 - January 21, 2021



It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Robert Michael (Bob) Cashato. He passed away on Thursday, January 21, 2021 after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

Bob was the youngest of the Cashato family and grew up in Vancouver - Burnaby area. He moved to Cranbrook in 1972 where he began work with Crestbrook Forest Industries at the Skookumchuck Pulp Mill. He retired from the pulp mill in 2005. His early days in Cranbrook would be spent at Echo Field racing his stock car #39. He enjoyed life on a motorcycle riding around BC and fixing old wrecks.
